- 5.3 Spot-spraying has taken place on Great Common to further knock-back the thistles, it remains to be seen if more spraying will be required next year.

- 6.1 Information on the website was up-to-date.
- 6.2 It was agreed that the dissertation by Neema Binu on pond conservation that used, amongst other data, the results of the LMC Pond Survey should be put on the website.

- 6.3 RL reported that in June, compared to the previous month, the website had been accessed by 47 users, down by 12% but there had been 74 sessions, up 4.2%. 50% of users accessed the site directly whilst 36% accessed it via another link.
