2. Status of New Directors

- 2.1 Increasing the number of directors from six to eight has proved more difficult than anticipated. The Company's Articles of Association need to be amended to reflect the changes before being sent to Companies House but unfortunately, they only exist in paper form. Lovewell Blake have said that that they can convert the paper form into a digital one containing the amendments and lodge them with Companies House for about £200. It was agreed that the number of directors should be increased to 10 in case of further increases in the future, (though none were anticipated), and that Lovewell Blake be instructed to carry out the work.

5. Finance

- 5.1 The current financial position showed total funds of £76318. Since the last meeting there has been no receipts but there had been payments for a number of items which were detailed in the accounts that had been previously circulated.
- 5.2 As agreed at the meeting in January, a further £10,000 has been invested in a fixed rate bond. This is with Cambridge and Counties Bank at a rate of 3.75%. Hampshire Trust Bond Number 2 matures on 25th April and it was agreed to re-invest for one year at a rate of 3.7%. Action; JB
- 5.3 It was agreed to renew the Company's membership of Suffolk Wildlife Trust and include a donation, a total of £200 and pay £50 for the hire of the Village Hall on 25th February (AGM) and tonight.

- 5.4 T B-F confirmed that the application for BPS 2023 had been submitted.
- 5.5 Sources of future funding was discussed. T B-F will investigate what is available via Suffolk FWAG and Tim Schofield. JP will speak to Sam Brown to see what surveys she recommends.

6. LMC Website and LMC Promotion

6.1 CR reported that the website has been updated as and when necessary. He thought that the website needed a refresh and additional videos would a way of achieving that.

7. Winter Work Programme

7.1 There had been several work parties with enthusiastic volunteers. Overhanging branches at Beck's Green had been removed and sallows by the pond at Great Common south had been cleared in order to let more light in.
